SUMMER VOLUNTEERS

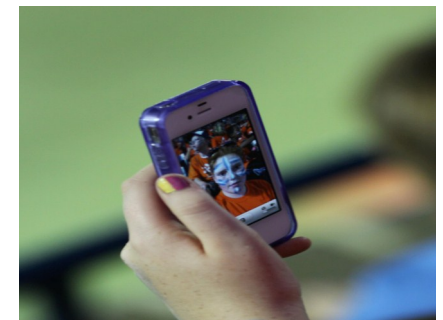
Volunteers must be 16 years of age and provide a police record check. If you are interested in volunteering within our summer camp programs please contact the Volunteer Coordinator.

General Information

What you need to know

Camper Age Limit. The teen camp is for campers between the ages of 13-15. Campers can be 12 years old as long as they turn 13 by December 31st, 2016.

Registration is available on-line and at both units as of February 20th, 2017

Registration Cut off date. The cut off for each week of camp is the Wednesday prior to the start of the session you are registering for.
Payment methods. When registering for camp methods of payment are cash, credit card or cheque. Debit is available at the Eastview Unit. Please note cheques will only be accepted if dated **30 days prior to the start of camp**. Also post-dated cheques must be dated 30 days prior to the start of camp.

***Some trips or off-site outings may not be covered and campers will be expected to bring their own entrance fees and spending money.**

Based on registration and/or availability of venues scheduled trips may be subject to change. Every effort will be made to inform campers in a timely manner.
